Liquid, Anti-Washout Admixture for Underwater Concrete

DESCRIPTION

Mapeplast[™] UWL is a liquid admixture that has been specifically developed to make highly cohesive and pumpable concrete and mortars, ideal to cast anti-washout concrete underwater. Due to its special formulation, adding Mapeplast UWL to the concrete mix improves its cohesion and increases its resistance to washout when it comes into contact with still or slow-moving water. Mapeplast UWL complies with the requirements of U.S. Army Corps of Engineers CRD-C 661-06 Specifications for Antiwashout Admixture for Concrete.

WHERE TO USE

Mapeplast UWL may be added to all strength classes of both traditional and self-compacting concrete for the following types of underwater application:

- Rebuilding and repair work
- Structural elements
- Foundations

Mapeplast UWL can also be used as a viscosity-modifying agent to stabilize or improve the robustness of self-consolidating concrete mixes in all applications.

CASTING TECHNIQUE

Concrete admixed with Mapeplast UWL may be applied using all traditional casting techniques, in particular:

- Through a hose
- By pumping
- From a hopper
- Along a chute



It is very important that underwater concrete is correctly applied to guarantee the maximum efficiency of *Mapeplast UWL*. When casting concrete, it is recommended to reduce its contact with water as much as possible and to make sure concrete flows slowly at a constant rate. Underwater concrete pumping is generally the most reliable technique because, once pumped at a higher pressure, it helps reduce segregation and honeycombs.

WARNING

Mapeplast UWL significantly increases the concrete viscosity, thus making it more sticky to the sides of the mixing drums. It is strongly recommended to carefully wash the concrete mixers at the end of the production process to avoid contamination between the concrete admixed with Mapeplast UWL and subsequent batches.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Mapeplast UWL is a ready-to-use product. It can be added in the mixer with all the other ingredients (water, cement, aggregates, and admixtures). Mix until well blended.

Concrete admixed with Mapeplast UWL may be applied using all traditional casting techniques, in particular:

- Through a hose
- By pumping
- From a hopper
- Along a chute

COMPATIBILITY WITH OTHER PRODUCTS

Mapeplast UWL may provide some plasticizing effect depending on the binder, therefore, the dosage in high-range water reducer might have to be adjusted.

Mapeplast UWL is compatible with all the other admixtures of the MAPEI range except Mapefluid $^{\text{TM}}$ N200 [NA].

MAPEI's Technical Services Department is available to evaluate which admixture or admixture packages are most suitable for any specific need.

DOSAGE RATES

The required dosage for *Mapeplast UWL* depends on specific site requirements. In general, it may vary from 200 to 500 mL per 100 kg to achieve anti-washout properties and from 100 to 300 mL per 100 kg as a viscosity modifying agent.

Different dosages from those suggested must be previously tested through concrete trials, in addition to consulting MAPEI Technical Services Department.

PACKAGING

Mapeplast UWL is available in 208-L drums and 1 041-L totes.



STORAGE

Mapeplast UWL can be stored for 6 months in sealed containers protected from frost. It is recommended to protect the product from damp and prolonged direct exposure to sunlight. Preferably store the product at a temperature range of 5 to 35°C. Verify product homogeneity if the product has been stored unused for a period of more than 3 months or ask your local MAPEI representative to verify product conformity before use.

Choose all appropriate safety equipment before use. When applying the product, wear protective gloves and goggles and take the usual precautions for handling of chemicals. If the product comes in contact with the eyes or skin, wash immediately with plenty of water and seek medical attention.
