The majestic Westin Diplomat resort and spa is a historical icon to the city of Hollywood, Florida. One year later, a completely new hotel was introduced to the public with a grandeur that is quite convincingly unique.

It took 3.5 million man-hours in construction to build the Westin Diplomat. Designed by NBS Architects, from Coral Gables, Florida, the hotel stretches along the Atlantic coast, reflecting the ocean and rising 34 stories high. Inside, the lobbies, restaurants and 1000 guest rooms greet guests with a medley of Spanish marble, French limestone and ceramic tile that accentuate the grandeur of Broward county's largest structure.
